The meeting of the Board of Studies in Commerce (PG) is held on Wednesday (10.03.2021) at 2.00 p.m. in the Post Graduate and Research Centre of Commerce, G.T.N. Arts College (Autonomous), Dindigul. Following resolutions have been made.

Resolutions:

It is resolved

- (i) to condense and to be specific in the Syllabus
- (ii) to add latest text books and reference books
- (iii) to include appropriate e-resources and to include NPTEL and ICAI study material as e-resources for as many courses as possible.

Regarding the course "Advanced Corporate Accounting"

(1) It is resolved to include "Final Accounts of companies" as I Unit.

(2) It is resolved to bring the "Accounts of Holding Companies", "Accounts of Banking Companies", "Accounts of Insurance Companies" and "Double Accounting system and Accounts of Electricity Companies" as unit II, III, IV and V respectively.

(3) It is resolved to remove unit VI i.e. Accounting Standards and Financial Reporting Practices.

Regarding the course "Business Research Methods"

(1) It is resolved to remove 'Maintaining Objectivity in Research' from the I Unit.

(2) It is resolved to include "Identification

and selection of research problems in the II unit

- ⑤ It is resolved to remove "Hypothesis - Meaning, Formulation and Testing" from the III unit and put the same in Unit IV.
- ⑥ It is resolved to add "Research Methodology" written by C.R. Gupta as another text book.

As regards the course "Organisational Behaviour"

(1) It is resolved to merge Unit (IV) (Motivation) with Unit V i.e. Leadership and Communication

(2) It is resolved to have a separate unit for "Stress Management".

As regards the course, "Consumer Rights and Education",

(1) It is resolved to change the caption of Unit I as "Consumerism - An Overview" instead of "Consumer Movement in India".

(2) It is resolved to change the caption of Unit II as "Consumer Education in India" instead of "Consumer Rights and Education".

(3) It is resolved to include "Competitive Commission Act 2010" in Unit III.

As regards the course "Advanced Financial Management"

(1) It is resolved to change the caption of

Unit I as "Introduction to Finance" instead of "Foundations of Finance".

(2) It is resolved to change the order of course units as "Cost of Capital and Working Capital Management", "Capital Budgeting and Risk Analysis in Capital Budgeting" and "Dividend Policies" instead of "Sources of Finance and Financial Planning", "Management of Current Assets", and "Capital Budgeting" respectively.

(3) It is resolved to add "International Financial Management" as last unit of the syllabus.

§ ~~A.B~~ regards the course, "Goods and Services Tax and Customs Duty".

(1) It is resolved to change the course title as "Indirect Taxes" instead of "Goods and Services Tax and Customs Duty".

(2) It is resolved to change the caption of Unit II as "Registration and Valuation under Goods and Services Tax" instead of "Goods and Services Tax".

(3) It is resolved to bring "Input Tax Credit" as Unit III.

As regards "Banking Technology" course,

(1) It is resolved to change the caption of Unit I as "Introduction to Digital Technology" instead of "Introduction to Banking Technology", Unit II as "Card Based Electronic Payment System" instead of "Computerised Banking", Unit III as "Non-Card Electronic Payment System" instead of "Electronic Fund Transfer", Unit IV as "Cyber Security" instead of "Information Technology in Banking" and Unit V as "Data Protection" instead of "Data Management".

Regarding the course, "Corporate Social Responsibility"

(1) It is resolved to change the caption of Unit I as "ESR and Corporate Ethics" instead of "CSR and Consumer Behaviour" and to change the contents accordingly.

Regarding 'Project'

(1) It is resolved to have a reschedule schedule to be followed by the PG students to complete the Project work on time.

In order to overcome the difficulties faced by the students, it is resolved to change the examination pattern.

- Seminar / Quiz / Group Discussion – 5 marks
(If Quiz is conducted, the average of two quizzes is taken for 5 marks)
- Third test may be allowed for absentees of anyone of the two assessments for genuine reasons.

Continuous Internal Assessment (CIA) - PG

The pattern of question paper for Continuous Internal Assessment (CIA) for PG for III and IV is as follows. The duration for the assessment is 2 hours. Equal importance is given to all the units.

(The average of two quizzes is taken for 5 marks)
3. Seminar / Group Discussion – 5 marks
4. Third test may be allowed for absentees of anyone of the two assessments for genuine reasons.

End Semester Examinations (ESE)

Post Graduate

1. A Passing minimum of 45% in external examination out of 60 i.e. 27 out of 60 will be taken as pass mark for PG students.
