Annual Report 2022-2023

It's my pleasant privilege to present the 59th Annual report with a summary of our achievements on the academic, co-curricular and the extra-curricular front in the year 2022-2023. Seminars, workshops, and invited lectures are the routine features of the G.T.N. intellectual climate.

College Strength

The College has the optimum students' admission in all courses of both aided and self-supporting with 4833 in total. The intake of the students has increased by 15 compared to last year. The faculty's strength is enlarged to 258 with the inclusion of new appointments in aided and in self-supporting mode. Dr. Ilakkia joined in the month of September 2022 and Dr. T. Logu joined in the month of November 2022 as Assistant Professors in the Department of Commerce and Physics respectively. The Institution Innovation Council was awarded with Four Star Rating by Ministry of Education during the academic year 2022-2023. DBT Star College has received a grant of Rs. 82 Lakhs, as a non-recurring amount (exclusively for instruments) and amount of Rs. 40 lakhs was sanctioned as first instalment. The Star College inauguration will be held in the month of June 2023. The College was certified with ISO 9001:2015 by Integral Certification Private Limited, Delhi. Understanding the scope, the new academic

programmes of M.Sc. Clinical Embryology and Reproductive Genetics and B.Sc. Geology will be offered in the ensuing academic year 2023-2024.

Admission

The admission of students was carried out by a duly constituted admission committee. The selection was purely on merit basis and in accordance with the guidelines of Government of Tamil Nadu and M.K University. 50% of the Management Quota was allotted to the students who narrowly missed their chance to make it in the Mark list and to the deserving students.

IQAC

The IQAC team of the college has been functioning since 2014 with a mission in enhancing and sustaining Excellence in its academic and administrative practices and to set benchmarks for their periodic evaluation.

The IQAC of the college has submitted the Self Study Report for the NAAC Cycle – 2 on 21st March 2023 and Data Validation and Verification (DVV) Clarification was submitted on 07th April 2023.

IQAC has conducted two student skill Enhancement programmes on “Importance of Communication Skill for Higher Learning” and “Soft Skills for Entrepreneurship on 25th August 2022. It has organized a student’s Awareness Programme in Collaboration with R & D cell on 12th August 2022. It has also organised a Faculty Enrichment Programme in Association with IIC.
